The Forty Hours Devotion is the Solemn Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament over three days marked with special devotions:

Thursday 8 June	6:30pm High Mass & Adoration til midnight
Friday 9 June	Adoration 9:30am to midnight. 6:00pm Evening Oratory
Saturday 10 June	Adoration 9:30am ending with 5:00pm Motets & Solemn Benediction

The Blessed Sacrament must have adorers during this time, and we invite parishioners to sign up for an hour at the entrance of Mary Immaculate Church, and especially men during evening hours. We hope all parishioners at MI and SJF make a holy hour during the Forty Hours and we invite you to join us for the opening Mass and/or closing Benediction with special prayers of intercession for the good of the Church. Exposition at SE continues as usual.

The Archdiocesan **Corpus Christi Procession** is next Sunday, June 11, starting at 2:00pm at the Cathedral. Please note that we will not have Vespers and Benediction next Sunday.
