The Maxims and Counsels of St Philip Neri: Let us be humble and keep ourselves down: Obedience! Humility! Detachment!

We celebrate our national patroness, **Our Lady Help of Christians**, on Monday with High Mass at 9:00am. Confessions will be during the 9:00am Mass. We will also have Vespers and Benediction at 6:00pm in the evening followed by wine and cheese in the hall. Please note that there is no Mass or confessions this Monday evening.

The celebrations continue on Tuesday with the feast of **St Philip Neri**, founder of the Oratory, with High Mass at 10:30am. Please note that this is the only Mass on Tuesday, and no scheduled confessions.

On Thursday evening we celebrate the feast of **Corpus Christi** according to the older calendar, with High Mass at 6:30pm, and this will open our annual **Forty Hours Devotion**. Exposition will continue after Mass until 9:00pm. On Friday, exposition will resume after the 9:00am Mass, as it will on Saturday morning following the 8:30am Mass. On Friday and Saturday, we encourage everyone to visit the church at some time to spend time with Our Lord, asking his blessing on our families and parish community. On Friday and Saturday the Angelus and Rosary will be prayed at noon, and the Divine Mercy Chaplet prayed at 3:00pm. On Friday evening at 6:00pm you are invited to join the Fathers and Brothers for our Evening Oratory in the church, there will also be the usual Friday evening Confessions, with exposition concluding at 9:00pm. The Forty Hours will conclude on Saturday at 5:00pm with Motets and Benediction.

St Philip Neri Joyful Knitting and Crochet Group begins this Friday 5 June and will be every 1st Friday of the month thereafter straight after 9:00am Mass. The 5 June meeting will be in the hall. Starting project: much needed knee rugs for First Nations people in palliative care. Please bring 4mm knitting needles or crochet hook and 8 ply yarn if you can. Any parishioners with 8 ply yarn to donate please drop off to the parish office.

Next Sunday, June 7, all parishioners are invited to join the parish group in the **Corpus Christi Procession**, commencing at 2:00pm at the Cathedral of St Stephen. Please note that our 4:00pm Mass that day will be cancelled to allow people to attend the procession. Vespers and the 6:00pm Mass will be on as usual.

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.

FIRST READING | Exodus 34:4-6,8-9

With the two tablets of stone in his hands, Moses went up the mountain of Sinai in the early morning as the Lord had commanded him.
